Subj: CHANGE ONE (CH-1) TO FY-05 NAVSEA STANDARD ITEMS (SI's)

1. Change One (CH-1) to the FY-2005 NAVSEA SI's, consisting of a revised SI 009-32, Cleaning and Painting Requirements; accomplish, has been posted on the SSRAC web site and can be downloaded at www.supship.navy.mil/ssrac4/standard.htm.
2. SI 009-32 has been revised to incorporate changes mandated by the NAVSEA technical authority (SEA 05M), among which is the broadening of the requirement for contractor certification under SSPC QP-1 (3.6.5.1). Certification will be required of contractors preparing surfaces prior to painting for all areas designated critically coated (regardless of size).
3. This change is effective for all availabilities in which FY-05 SI's are invoked. However, in accordance with COMNAVSEASYS COM 090511Z APR 04 (Paragraph 7), QP-1 certification must be obtained by 01 January 2005.
4. Activity SSRAC Coordinators are responsible for advising MSR/ABR contractors under their cognizance of this change. The requirements of this letter do not authorize any change in terms, conditions, delivery schedule, price, or amount of any existing Government contract.
